AN ORDINANCE Amending the Code of Ordinances, Title V, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, Section 30-3-23, Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee.

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

Section I: Amend the Code of Ordinances, Title V, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, Section 30-3-23, Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee, by deleting the section in its entirety and replacing with the following:

30-3-23 Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee.

- (a) The Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee shall consist of thirteen members. The Director of Recreation and Parks shall be the Clerk of the Committee. The members of the Committee shall be appointed as follows:
 - (1) Ten (10) members, one from each ward, shall be nominated by the Mayor and be subject to approval by the City Council.
 - (2) One (1) member representing the Concord School District.
 - (3) One (1) member representing the Merrimack Valley School District
 - (4) One (1) City Councilor to be appointed by the Mayor.
- (b) The Recreation Superintendent, Recreation and Parks Maintenance Superintendent, and Director of Recreation and Parks as Ex-officio, non-voting members.
- (c) The Committee shall:
 - (1) Elect its own chairman and vice chairman.
 - (2) Submit an annual report to the City Council on the state of the Recreation and Parks Division.
 - (3) Initiate and update a five-year needs and program plan for the Recreation and Parks Division.
 - (4) Recommend to the City Manager a sound fiscal plan of income and expenses which best addresses community recreation needs and resources.

AN ORDINANCE

Amending the Code of Ordinances, Title V, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, Section 30-3-23, Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee (page 2).

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

(4) Recommend to the City Manager changes that will result in improvements to all aspects of the operations of the Recreation and Parks Division.

(d) The City Council representative shall serve a two-year term; other members shall be appointed for three years.

Section II:

In the first instance, the appointment of the members shall be as follows; thereafter they shall be appointed as provided in Section 30-3-23(c):

(1) The members representing Wards 1, 2, and 3 shall be appointed for a three-year term.

(2) The members representing Wards 4, 5, and 6 shall be for a one-year term.


(3) The member representing Wards 7, 8, 9, and 10 shall be for a two-year term.

Section III:

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
