- Discussion of Concord 100% renewable campaign:

Rob: Concord Hospital has indicated that they are supportive. Rob and Rich will continue to meet with them to coordinate their support. The Concord Monitor may also be writing a supportive editorial.

Evan: SEIU/SEA has expressed their support for the resolution as well. Evan will follow up with them as well.

Joe: Will reach out to some larger developers and others in town.

Zach: We have had positive contact with 8 of the City Councilors. Several other folks have not yet had meetings, and one or two of the Councilors have expressed concerns that we are working to address.

- Discussion of City Property Energy Initiatives Committee:

Rob: New committee to help support new energy projects. Very excited and want to move quickly on the solar project at the landfill. Rob will follow up with the Mayor and other councilors involved to see how we can help.

- Discussion of Sol-Smart Program:

Rob: The National Renewable Energy Lab offers free consulting for municipalities on solar and other renewables. This is a service the city should definitely take advantage of.
