ARMED ROBBERY AT RESIDENCE: TWO SUSPECTS ARRESTED

CONCORD – On February 5, 2019 at approximately 4:34AM, Concord Police Officers were dispatched to 44 Dunklee St. for a report of a disturbance involving weapons and threats. After investigating the circumstances of the incident, police arrested:

**NATHANIEL WAYNE GIBBS Age, 36yrs
OSSIPPEE, NH.**

Gibbs was charged with:

**ARMED ROBBERY RSA 636:1 FELONY “A”
SECOND DEGREE ASSAULT RSA 631:2 FELONY “B”**

And

**ELIAS ROSS YOUNG Age, 21yrs
OSSIPPEE, NH**

Young was charged with:

ARMED ROBBERY RSA 636:1 FELONY “A”

Both men were held pending arraignment at the **Merrimack County Superior Court** on **Wednesday February 6, 2019 at 1pm.** In addition, Mr. Young had an unrelated warrant for Simple Assault out of Center Harbor, NH.

Responding officers made contact with three people (two male suspects) inside of a truck outside of 44 Dunklee, and another male (victim) inside the residence had been assaulted and threatened with knives. The victim was treated at a local hospital for his injuries. Investigators recovered weapons in possession of the suspects as well as property belonging to the victim. Investigators learned that the males were all acquainted and that drugs may have been at the root of the incident.

Investigators are currently applying for search warrants regarding the case and the investigation is active. A third person, the driver of the truck, was questioned and released.
