Endangering the Welfare of a Child

CONCORD, NH – On April 11, 2021 Concord Police Officers responded to the Willow Crossing Apartment complex on Village St. for the report of a juvenile female being assaulted the previous day on April 10, 2021. It was reported that the juvenile was assaulted multiple times and placed in a situation that she was almost set on fire. After several days of investigation, the Concord Police arrested:

Ajby turned herself into the Concord Police Department on April 14, 2021. Ajby was held on preventative detention and held at the Merrimack County Jail until her arraignment.

Ajby was arraigned this afternoon at the Merrimack County Superior Court. She was released on Personal Recognizance bail.
