CONCORD, NH --- On Sunday, September 18, 2022 at approximately 9:25 p.m. the Concord Police Department responded to Seven-Eleven, located at 9 Village St. for the report of an armed robbery. The suspect was a white male, dressed in all black.

The suspect pointed what appeared to be a firearm at the store clerk, and demanded money and cigarettes. The suspect fled the store with an undisclosed amount of money and cigarettes.

The Concord Police Department is seeking any information related to this incident and attempting to identify and speak with an uninvolved male witness who was inside of the store at the time of the armed robbery.
