CONCORD, NH – On March 28, 2023 the Concord Police Department Patrol Division took a report of a man exposing himself in the window of a downtown apartment. The report to police indicated the male exposed himself in the apartment window for an extended period of time. Other witnesses were identified, interviewed, and reported the male exposed himself while looking through binoculars toward downtown Concord.

Four days later, on April 1, 2023, an off-duty Concord Police Officer was downtown when he observed a male exposing himself in the window of a nearby apartment.

With the assistance of Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division, the window the male was seen exposing himself in was identified as the same window from the incident the week prior. The male exposing himself was identified and determined to be a registered sex offender.

As a result of this investigation, probable cause was established. On April 19, 2023 the following individual was arrested and charged:

Christopher Dastrup (38 years old)
Concord, NH

Dastrup was charged with:

Indecent Exposure/Lewdness 2 priors (Felony) X 2

Dastrup refused the services of a bail commissioner. Dastrup is currently being held on unrelated charges at the NH State Prison for Men. Dastrup is scheduled to be arraigned in the Merrimack County Superior Court on April 20, 2023 at 1 p.m.
