

Reckless Motor Vehicle Operation

CONCORD, NH- The Concord Police Department is currently investigating a Reckless Motor Vehicle Operation complaint. On Friday, May 19, 2023 at approximately 7:50 p.m. a black colored Ford Taurus fled from Concord Police Officers at a high rate of speed. The suspect vehicle was traveling northbound on Storrs Street underneath the Legislative Parking Garage. During the incident, the suspect vehicle nearly struck an oncoming vehicle (a white Subaru with headlights on) that was traveling southbound on Storrs Street.

The Concord Police Department is attempting to identify the operator of the white Subaru vehicle (pictured with headlights on) or any other witnesses to this incident.
