CONCORD, NH – On June 5, 2023, Concord Police arrested:

Justin Spaulding, Age 41
Bow, NH

Spaulding is charged with:

Possession of Child Sex Abuse Images (Felony) X 10

In October 2022, members of the Concord Police Department's Computer Crimes Unit (CCU) launched an investigation into child pornography being shared via the internet. Over the course of several months, search warrants were executed, interviews were conducted, and evidence was examined. As a result of the investigation probable cause was established to charge Spaulding with ten counts of Possession of Child Sex Abuse Images.

On June 5, 2023, Spaulding turned himself into the Concord Police Department on an outstanding arrest warrant. After being processed, Spaulding requested the services of a Bail Commissioner. Spaulding was released on Personal Recognizance bail. Spaulding is scheduled to appear in the Merrimack County Superior Court on June 22, 2023 for arraignment.

The NH Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force and the Bow Police Department assisted the Concord Police Department in this investigation.
