CONCORD, NH – On June 5, 2023, Concord Police arrested:

Timothy Byron, Age 35
Concord, NH

Byron is charged with:

Sale of a Controlled Drug with Death Resulting (Felony)
Falsifying Physical Evidence (Felony)

On September 5, 2022, members of the Concord Police Department responded with the Concord Fire Department to Mayflower Drive for a reported drug overdose. The victim was located and transported to Concord Hospital where they were pronounced deceased. Over the course of nine months, Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division conducted an extensive investigation.

As a result of the investigation, probable cause was established to charge Byron with Sale of a Controlled Drug with Death Resulting and Falsifying Physical Evidence. On May 22, 2023, an arrest warrant was issued for Byron.

On June 5, 2023, Byron was located and arrested on the outstanding warrant by the Hooksett Police Department. After being processed at the Concord Police Department, Byron requested the services of a Bail Commissioner. Byron was released on Personal Recognizance bail. Byron is scheduled to appear in the Merrimack County Superior Court on June 22, 2023 for arraignment.

The Concord Police Department was assisted in this investigation by the NH Chief Medical Examiner's Office and the NH Attorney General's Office.
