On August 20, 2023 at approximately 12:45 a.m., Concord Police responded to the area of Depot Street for the report of a disturbance. Upon arrival, a female victim was found unconscious and a male trying to tend to her injuries. Three individuals were later transported to the hospital for serious injuries.

Based on the investigation, it was learned that the incident originated from WOW Billiards, 2 North Main Street. A group of individuals gathered and chased the victims to Depot Street where they attacked and violently assaulted the victims.

All three subjects are being held at the Merrimack County House of Corrections on preventative detention. They are scheduled to be arraigned at Merrimack County Superior Court on September 8, 2023.

This investigation is active and ongoing.
