CONCORD, NH – On September 13, 2023 at 7:25 p.m. the Concord Police Department took a report of a Missing Person. The Missing Person was identified as a male from Concord.

At 11:30 p.m., the male's vehicle was located in the parking lot of the Everett Arena (15 Loudon Road). With the assistance of the Concord Fire Department, search efforts focused in the area of the Merrimack River. At 1 a.m., the Merrimack River water search was temporarily suspended, but search efforts on land continued throughout the overnight hours.

With the assistance of the NH Fish & Game Dive Team, Merrimack River search efforts resumed at 8 a.m. At 8:45 a.m., the male was located by the Dive Team and was pronounced deceased by Concord Fire personnel.

An autopsy has been scheduled to determine manner and cause of death. The name of the male is being withheld pending notification of next of kin. At this time foul play is not suspected.
