CONCORD, NH – On November 27, 2023, Concord Police arrested:

**Nicholas Sanville, Age 37**  
**Candia, NH**

Sanville is charged with:

**Trafficking in Persons (Felony)**  
**Sex Offender Registration; Failure to Comply (Misdemeanor)**  
**Simple Assault (Misdemeanor)**

On July 22, 2023 Concord Police took a report of a sexual encounter between a juvenile female and a registered sex offender. The victim was interviewed at the Merrimack County Child Advocacy Center where she disclosed being assaulted and being propositioned for sex by Sanville in exchange for items to include gifts, money, drugs, and food.

Over the course of four months, Detectives conducted interviews, executed search warrants, and collected evidence which corroborated the victim's statement. Detectives also learned Sanville was not in compliance with the conditions of his sex offender registration requirements. As a result, probable cause was established to charge Sanville with Trafficking in Persons, Failure to Comply with Sex Offender Registration, and Simple Assault.

Sanville was arrested on November 27, 2023 by the Candia Police Department and processed at the Concord Police Department. After being processed, Sanville refused the services of a Bail Commissioner and was transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Sanville is scheduled to appear in the Merrimack County Superior Court on November 28, 2023 for arraignment.
