CONCORD, NH – On January 8, 2024 at approximately 4:55 a.m., Concord Police and Fire responded to the report of a vehicle versus pedestrian collision on Clinton Street, between Langley Parkway and Norwich Street.

The pedestrian, who sustained serious and life-threatening injuries, was transported by ambulance to Concord Hospital and then later transferred to a Boston Hospital.

The driver of the vehicle did not stop and has not been identified at this point in time. Preliminary investigation has determined that the victim was walking east on Clinton Street wearing a high visibility vest. The victim was struck by the passenger side mirror of a passing vehicle. Evidence recovered from the scene suggests that the suspect vehicle is a Volkswagen Jetta, between the model year 2015 to 2017. The vehicle color is unknown but it is missing the passenger side mirror. The vehicle was travelling east towards South Street in Concord at the time of the incident.
