CONCORD, NH – On January 12, 2024, just after 11:00 a.m., Concord Police and Fire responded to a multi vehicle collision on Loudon Road, between Fort Eddy Road and Hazen Drive. Five people were transported to Concord Hospital, one of which is in critical condition. **Update: the person who was in critical condition succumbed to injuries sustained in the accident and has passed away.

Preliminary investigation has determined that a vehicle was travelling west on Loudon Road and rear ended a vehicle stopped at the traffic light at the intersection of Loudon Road and Fort Eddy Road. The force of the impact resulted in multiple injuries and vehicular damage.

Loudon Road at Fort Eddy Road will be shut down for several hours while accident reconstruction and investigation take place. Expect delays in the immediate area and seek alternate routes to access the Heights area of Concord and Interstate 93 at exit 14 (N and S).
