CONCORD, NH – On January 14, 2024, just before 5 a.m., Concord Police officers responded to Broad Cove Drive to investigate a 911 report that a man had been breaking into a vehicle. That same man was confronted by the vehicle owner and was subsequently injured during the confrontation. Concord Fire responded and transported the man to Concord Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Officers secured the scene and preserved evidence for detectives, who arrived shortly thereafter. It is believed that the same man had gone through several other unlocked vehicles in the area prior to the confrontation.

Residents on Broad Cove Drive and the surrounding streets are asked to check their vehicles and outbuildings to see if they were victimized. If so, please contact the Concord Police Department. Residents in the area are also asked to check their camera systems for any suspicious activity that would have occurred overnight, into the early morning hours. Again, if any suspicious activity was captured on camera systems the Concord Police is asking that the camera footage be preserved and the Concord Police be notified at 603-225-8600.
