CONCORD, NH – On January 25, 2024 at about 7:27 p.m. the Concord Police Department fielded several 9-1-1 calls regarding shots being fired from the area of Hanover Street. Officers learned that someone had fired a gun outside in the area of Hanover Street and then returned into a Hanover Street residence. Officers contacted the occupants and secured the residence.

An individual was identified, arrested and charged:

Jayden Ballam-Quiah, 18 years old
Concord, NH

Ballam-Quiah has been charged with:

Reckless Conduct (Felony)
Unauthorized Use of a Firearm (Violation)
Breach of Bail Conditions (Misdemeanor)

Ballam-Quiah was processed at the Concord Police Department. Ballam-Quiah requested the services of a bail commissioner and was held on preventative detention. Ballam-Quiah was subsequently transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Ballam-Quiah is scheduled to be arraigned in the 6th Circuit Court- District Division- Concord on January 26, 2024.
