CONCORD, NH – On March 26, 2024, Concord Police arrested an adult female. Arrested was:

Kaitlin Cook, Age 34
Concord, NH

Cook is charged with:

First Degree Assault w/Deadly Weapon (Felony)
Second Degree Assault w/Deadly Weapon (Felony)
Criminal Threatening w/Deadly Weapon (Felony)
Reckless Conduct w/Deadly Weapon (Felony)

On March 16, 2024 at about 2:45 p.m. the Concord Police Department received a call about a male who was found laying on the side of the I-93 Northbound Exit 13 on-ramp, near Manchester Street, bleeding. The male reported that he had been shot. Members of the Concord Police and Fire Departments responded and located the male. The male was transported to Concord Hospital and found to have sustained serious and life-threatening injuries.

The investigation revealed the male had been shot with a BB-gun at a homeless camp within Healy Park. Numerous interviews were conducted, a search warrant was executed, and physical evidence was collected from the scene. Kaitlin Cook was identified as the shooter.

On March 22, 2024 an arrest warrant was obtained for Cook. On March 26, 2024 Concord Police located and arrested Cook on the warrant. Cook was transported to the Concord Police Department where she was processed without incident. Cook refused the services of a bail commissioner and was transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Cook is scheduled to appear in the Concord District Court on March 26, 2024 for arraignment.
