On March 30, 2024 Concord Police Officers were sent to an address on Iron Works Road, in the vicinity of Martin Field and Madison Street, to investigate a random attack. A local resident reported that shortly after 10 p.m. she was on her back porch when a stranger emerged from a wooded area. The stranger ran towards the victim, pushed her down by the throat and struck her multiple times in the face. When the attack ended the suspect ran out of the yard in an unknown direction.

The victim described her attacker as being a white male, tall and thin with an unkempt, scraggly beard. She believed that he was likely in his late 30's, wearing a green and white plaid shirt.

Earlier in the evening a neighbor from Iron Works Road reported seeing a subject walking through backyards.

The Concord Police is seeking assistance from the public in identifying the perpetrator of this assault. If anyone observed suspicious behavior in the area of Iron Works Road, Madison Street, Martin field on March 30, 2024, between the hours of 8 p.m. and midnight they are asked to contact the Concord Police Department. The public is also asked to check their home video cameras for anything unusual during that timeframe.
