
CONCORD, NH- On April 9, 2024 at approximately 2:30 a.m. the Concord Police Department responded to the Shell Gas Station on Loudon Road to investigate the report of a Robbery. The on-duty clerk at the store had contacted a police officer passing by as he ran away from the store.

During the incident, a male suspect entered the store and contacted the clerk. The suspect then escorted the clerk outside the store, and placed a pillow case over the victim's face. The suspect also hand cuffed the victim and placed him in the front passenger seat of his own vehicle. The suspect re-entered the store where he began to fill pillow cases with merchandise. The clerk was able to escape the area where he contacted a police officer. The suspect fled the area prior to officers' arrival at the store.

The suspect is described as being a white male, approximately 6 feet tall with a medium build. The suspect was described as wearing a black Carhartt style jacket and a black face mask. The suspect was wearing a green and black colored draw string back pack.

The Concord Police Department is actively investigating this incident. There is no threat to the general public. Anyone who may have been driving in the area of the Shell Gas Station on Loudon Road in the area of the Everett Arena around the time of the incident, or anyone with information related to this incident, is asked to contact the Concord Police Department (603)225-8600.
