CONCORD, NH – May 7, 2024 is National Fentanyl Prevention and Awareness Day. This day is set aside to raise awareness of the dangers of opioids such as fentanyl. Last year, over 70,000 Americans fatally overdosed on illegally made fentanyl.

This day is being used to remember those who have lost their lives to drug overdoses and highlight the joint efforts of the Concord Police Department and NH State Police Narcotics Investigations Unit and announce 6-month *Operation Granite Shield* seizure totals. *Operation Granite Shield* is a grant-funded initiative targeting illegal drug trafficking in local communities.

Below is a list of seizures made by CPD/NHSP NIU investigators:

**Heroin/Fentanyl:** 1,224.8 grams (2.7 pounds)

**Methamphetamine:** 1,383.7 grams (3.0 pounds)

**Cocaine:** 330.9 grams

**Suboxone:** 86 sublingual strips

**Firearms:** 3 rifles, 1 handgun

The Concord Police Department, working with our federal, state, and local law enforcement partners, remains committed to raising awareness of the dangers of opioids and preventing drug overdoses.
