CONCORD, NH – On July 10, 2024, investigators from the Concord Police Department and the NH Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force executed a search warrant at a Bow Street residence in Concord.

Two individuals were arrested. Arrested were:

**Dylan Simms, Age 27**

**Concord, NH**

**(Distribution of Child Sex Abuse Images) X 3- Felony**

**Meredith Simms, Age 36**

**Concord, NH**

**(Tampering with Witnesses and Informants) – Felony**

**(Hindering Apprehension or Prosecution)- Misdemeanor**

The arrest of Dylan Simms is a result of a multi-month investigation conducted by the Concord Police Department Computer Crimes Unit working in conjunction with the NH ICAC Task Force and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. The Concord Police Department was also assisted by the Division for Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF).

After being processed, Dylan Simms was ordered to be held on preventative detention and is being held at the Merrimack County House of Corrections pending his arraignment in the Concord District Court on July 15, 2024. Meredith Simms was processed and released on personal recognizance bail.
