CONCORD, NH – On July 22, 2024 at about 3:35 p.m., the Concord Police Department received multiple calls about a vehicle off the road on Appleton Street. Further reports indicated multiple people fled from the vehicle into the woods. Upon arrival Officers learned the vehicle in question was previously reported stolen out of Hampton, NH. Responding officers observed a handgun in the vehicle.

A K-9 and drone was requested from the NH State Police to aid in the investigation. With the assistance of NH State Police and tips from the public, five individuals associated with the stolen vehicle were located, three juveniles and two adults. Arrested were:

During a secondary search of the area, an additional handgun was located. Ballam-Quiah was transported to the Concord Police Department where he was processed. Ballam-Quiah was ordered held on preventative detention and transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Ballam-Quiah was arraigned in the Concord District Court on July 23, 2024.

This investigation remains active and on-going.
