CONCORD, NH – On July 30, 2024, investigators from the Concord Police Department and the NH Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force executed a search warrant at a Crestwood Drive residence in Concord. Following the search, an arrest warrant was obtained for the following individual:

Jonathan Harrison, Age 31
Concord, NH

Harrison turned himself into Concord Police on August 19, 2024. Harrison is charged with:

Possession of Child Sex Abuse Images (Felony) X 3

The arrest of Jonathan Harrison is a result of a multi-month investigation conducted by the Concord Police Department Computer Crimes Unit working in conjunction with the NH ICAC Task Force and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. The Concord Police Department was also assisted in this investigation by the Maine State Police. Harrison was initially located and interviewed by Maine State Police on July 30, 2024.

After being processed at the Concord Police Department, Jonathan Harrison refused the services of a bail commissioner and is being held at the Merrimack County House of Corrections pending his arraignment in the Concord District Court on August 20, 2024.
