CONCORD, NH – On September 3, 2024 an individual by the name of:

**Matayo Riley, Age 27**  
**Concord, NH**

was convicted of Indecent Exposure in Concord District Court following an incident in May 2024 where he exposed his genitals to a female juvenile inside of the Concord Walmart. Less than three hours following his conviction in Concord District Court the Concord Police Department responded to a call about a male exposing his genitals to an adult woman inside of the Concord TJ Maxx. Upon further investigation, the suspect in this incident was identified as Riley. Riley was also identified as a suspect in an incident from August 28, 2024 where he exposed his genitals to two juvenile females under the age of 16 inside of the Concord Target. On September 3, 2024, Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division obtained arrest warrants for Riley as a result of the Target and TJ Maxx incidents. Riley was located later the same day and taken into custody. Riley is charged with:

**Indecent Exposure / Lewdness, subsequent offense (Felony)**  
**(September 3, 2024 TJ Maxx incident)**

**Indecent Exposure / Lewdness, sex act, child under 16 X 2 (Felony)**  
**(August 28, 2024 Target incident)**

Riley was transported to the Concord Police Department where he was processed. Riley refused the services of a bail commissioner and was transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Riley was arraigned in the Concord District Court on September 4, 2024.
