CONCORD, NH – On September 9, 2024 the Concord Police Department arrested:

Jeremy Ducharme, Age 42
Concord, NH

At approximately 10:15 p.m., Ducharme was arrested by the Concord Police Department on an arrest warrant stemming from an incident that occurred on August 15, 2024 where Ducharme is alleged to have been found in possession of a stolen handgun, methamphetamine, and fentanyl after attempting to conceal said items from police. While attempting to place Ducharme into custody, Ducharme fled from the patrol officers on foot, but was later located and apprehended.

Ducharme was arrested on the following charges stemming from the August 15, 2024 incident:

Receiving Stolen Property; Stolen Firearm (Felony)
Felon in Possession of a Dangerous Weapon (Felony)
Felonious Use of a Firearm (Felony)
Falsifying Physical Evidence (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug X 2 (Felony)

Ducharme was arrested on the following charges stemming from the September 9, 2024 incident:

Falsifying Physical Evidence (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug (Felony)
Resisting Arrest or Detention (Misdemeanor)

Ducharme was transported to the Concord Police Department where he was processed without incident. After being processed, Ducharme refused the services of a bail commissioner and was transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections in Boscawen, NH. Ducharme is scheduled to appear in the Concord District Court on September 10, 2024 for arraignment.
