### **Shooting at Rollins Park**

Concord, NH – On October 7, 2024 at approximately 8:45 p.m., Concord Police Officers were dispatched to Rollins Park to investigate a Shots Fired call for service. Several area residents reported hearing multiple gun shots in the area. All involved subjects had left the area prior to Officers' arrival at the park.

A subsequent investigation led to search warrants at several locations near the park. All involved subjects have been located and identified. One involved subject was transported to Concord Hospital with a non-life-threatening wound as a result of being struck by a bullet.

This appears to be an isolated incident and there is no danger to the public at this time. This incident remains an open and active investigation.
