CONCORD, NH – On October 7, 2024 the Concord Police Department responded to Rollins Park to investigate a Shots Fired call for service. All involved people had left the area prior to Officers' arrival at the park. One person was later located and transported to Concord Hospital with a non-life-threatening wound as a result of being struck by a bullet.

On October 25, 2024 an arrest warrant was obtained and the following individual was arrested related to the Rollins Park shooting:

Makeeva Laroche, 22 years old
Concord, NH

Laroche was charged with:

Attempted First Degree Murder (Felony) X 2
Attempted Second Degree Murder (Felony) X 2
Attempted First Degree Assault (Felony)
Attempted Second Degree Assault (Felony)
Attempted Robbery w/Firearm (Felony)
Conspiracy to Commit Robbery (Felony)
Felonious Use of a Firearm (Felony)
Criminal Threatening w/Firearm (Felony)
Falsifying Physical Evidence (Felony) X 2
Reckless Conduct w/Deadly Weapon (Felony)

Laroche was processed without incident at the Concord Police Department. Laroche requested the services of a bail commissioner and was ordered held on preventative detention. Laroche was transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Concord District Court on October 28, 2024.

This investigation remains open and ongoing.
