### **Bank Robbery**

CONCORD - On November 20, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. the Concord Police Department responded to the Bank of America located at 118 Storrs Street in Concord to investigate a bank robbery. Witnesses reported that a subject entered the bank and demanded money from an employee. The subject exited the bank with an undisclosed amount of money.

The suspect is a white male 5'7" to 5'8" who wore tan pants, a tan sweatshirt, black gloves, and a black ski mask with goggles which covered his eyes. There is no current threat to the community related to this incident.
