Criminal Threatening

Concord, NH – On December 2, 2024 at approximately 9:10 a.m. the Concord Police Department was dispatched to the area of Pleasant Street and Liberty Street to investigate a Criminal Threatening call for service. An investigation was initiated and an involved subject barricaded himself in an apartment. The Concord Police Department was able to contain the subject inside the apartment ensuring there was no danger to the public.
