ROBBERY ARREST

Concord, NH – On December 18, 2024, the Concord NH Police Department arrested the following individual:

John R. Griffin Jr. (Age 64)
Berlin, NH

Following a four-week, multi-jurisdictional investigation of a robbery that occurred on November 20, 2024 at the Bank of America at 118 Storrs Street in Concord, NH, probable cause was established and an arrest warrant was issued charging Griffin with the following offenses:

Robbery (Felony)
Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer (Felony)

Griffin was taken into custody in Gorham, NH. Griffin was transported to the Concord Police Department where he was processed without incident. Griffin refused the services of a Bail Commissioner and was transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Griffin is scheduled to be arraigned in the Concord District Court on Thursday, December 19, 2024 at 11 a.m.

Assistance in the investigation was provided by investigators from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), the New Hampshire Attorney General's Office Drug Task Force, and the Berlin NH Police Department.
