CONCORD, NH – On January 14, 2025, Concord Police arrested an adult male. Arrested was:

**Zaymen Burdette, Age 18  
Concord, NH**

Burdette is charged with:

**Sexual Assault (Misdemeanor) X 3  
Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor (Misdemeanor)  
Certain Uses of a Computer Prohibited (Felony)  
Possession of a Controlled Drug w/Intent to Distribute (Felony)**

In October of 2024, the Concord Regional Crimeline received a tip regarding a possible sexual assault of a juvenile female. The tip also contained information about an individual distributing controlled substances within the Concord area.

Detectives conducted interviews, executed search warrants, and collected both physical and digital evidence which corroborated the information contained in the Crimeline tip. As a result of the investigation probable cause was established to charge Burdette with Sexual Assault, Certain Uses of a Computer Prohibited, Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor, and Possession of a Controlled Drug w/Intent to Distribute. An arrest warrant was obtained on January 14, 2025 and Burdette was arrested.

Burdette was transported to the Concord Police Department to be processed. Burdette was detained in accordance with NH RSA 597:2. Burdette is scheduled to appear in the Concord District Court on January 15, 2025 for arraignment.
