### **Shooting at Healy Park**

CONCORD, NH – On January 16, 2025 the Concord Police Department received an anonymous tip regarding a shooting that occurred in the area of Healy Park and that the victim was missing. With limited information regarding the shooting or its exact location, Concord Police Department detectives began searching for the victim and following leads to the report of the shooting.

On January 17, 2025 the Concord Police Department was notified that the victim had been located within a tent in Healy Park. Concord Police Department detectives located the victim who was subsequently transported to Concord Hospital with life-threatening injuries.

During the investigation, the Concord Police Department received several anonymous tips regarding details of the incident. A person of interest was identified as:

**VINCENT MOTT, AGE 33**  
**CONCORD, NH**

On January 20, 2025 the Concord Police Department, with the assistance of the Central New Hampshire Special Operations Unit, arrested Vincent Mott on several active arrest warrants unrelated to this investigation. MOTT was charged with

**Warrant-Merrimack County Superior Court (Non-Appearance)**  
**Electronic Bench Warrant Concord District Court (Non-Appearance)**

While being taken into custody, MOTT was additionally charged with:

**(2 Counts) Acts Prohibited (Possession of Controlled Drugs) Felony**  
**Convicted Felons (Felony)**

***“Community Committed”***

## **Falsifying Physical Evidence (Felony)**

Mott was held on no bail due to the Merrimack County Superior Court warrant and transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. MOTT is to be arraigned on January 21, 2025 at 11 a.m. at Concord District Court.

The investigation into the shooting at Healy Park remains an open and active investigation. This appears to be an isolated incident and there is no danger to the public at this time.
