Merrimack River Incident

CONCORD, NH – On March 20, 2025, Concord Police Department and the Concord Fire Department responded to multiple 911 calls regarding a person observed in the Merrimack River near the Manchester Street Bridge. The person was described as a possible male wearing a dark-colored jacket.

Concord Police Officers and the Concord Fire Department responded to the area and began an immediate search of the area, both on land and in the water. The search efforts soon expanded with assistance from multiple agencies, to include the Merrimack County Sheriff's Office, the NH State Police Air and Marine Patrol units, NH Fish & Game, Bow Police Department, and Bow Fire Department.

At this time, no persons have been recovered from the Merrimack River. Concord Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident in an effort to identify or locate the individual observed in the river.
