Water Street Bridge Shooting

CONCORD, NH – On June 7, 2025, the Concord Police Department and the Concord Fire Department responded to the area under the Water Street Bridge in downtown Concord to investigate a Shots Fired call for service. A caller reported that a male in the homeless camp at that location had been shot and that the suspect had fled the area.

Concord Police Officers and the Concord Fire Department responded and located a 30-year-old male with an apparent gunshot wound to his back. The victim was transported to Concord Hospital and was found to have serious and life-threatening injuries as a result of being struck by a bullet. An extensive search of the area was conducted, with multiple persons questioned. No arrests have been made at this time related to the shooting.

This appears to be an isolated incident and there is no known danger to the public at this time. This incident remains an open and active investigation. The Concord Police Department is asking anyone with information pertaining to this incident to contact the Criminal Investigations Division at 603-225-8600.
