CONCORD, NH – In August 2024, the Concord Police Department, in coordination with the NH Attorney General’s Office, opened an investigation into suspected Trafficking of Persons and Prostitution related offenses involving the Oriental Bodywork Spa at 288 N. State Street in Concord, NH.

After a lengthy investigation, the Concord Police Department executed a criminal search warrant at the Oriental Bodywork Spa on July 30, 2025. Assisting the Concord Police Department in the investigation were members of the NH Attorney General’s Office, New Hampshire Department of Labor, Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), U.S. Customs and Border Protection and the U.S. Internal Revenue Service.

While executing the search warrant at the Oriental Bodywork Spa, the Concord Police Department arrested:

XUEYING WENG, AGE 49  
CONCORD, NH  
SIMPLE ASSAULT (CLASS A MISDEMEANOR)  
SEXUAL ASSAULT (CLASS A MISDEMEANOR)

SUHUA TANG, AGE 52  
CONCORD, NH  
PROSTITUTION (CLASS A MISDEMEANOR)

Xueying Weng and Suhua Tang were booked and processed at the Concord Police Department. Xueying Weng and Suhua Tang were held at the Merrimack County House of Correction on Preventative Detention. Xueying Weng was arraigned at the Concord District Court on July 31, 2025 at 11:00 A.M. Xueying Weng was held on Preventative Detention with a pending court date of August 27, 2025. Suhua Tang is scheduled for arraignment at Concord District Court on August 1, 2025 at 11:00 A.M.
