CONCORD, NH – On August 2, 2025 at about 1:30 p.m., the Concord Police Department responded to a report of an altercation in the downtown area. Officers arrived and discovered a group of about 20 people dressed alike and wearing face masks. This group was also displaying a flag with a swastika. It was also reported that an altercation took place between a bystander and people involved with the march. Responding officers spoke to several individuals involved, and the group left the area around 2:00 p.m. No arrests were made at the time.

This incident remains an open and active investigation. The Concord Police Department has received several video recordings of interactions that took place during this event. The Concord Police Department is attempting to identify individuals who may have been involved in the incident.
