DOWNTOWN ALTERCATION

CONCORD, NH – On August 2, 2025 at about 1:30 p.m., the Concord Police Department responded to a report of an altercation in the downtown area. Officers arrived and discovered a group of about 20 people dressed alike and wearing face masks. This group was also displaying a flag with a swastika. It was also reported that an altercation took place between a bystander and people involved with the march. Responding officers spoke to several individuals involved, and the group left around 2 p.m.

No arrests were made at that time, however this is an active investigation and the department expects to release more information soon.
