CONCORD, NH – On August 27, 2025 at approximately 10:35 p.m., Concord Police officers conducted a motor vehicle stop on a blue colored Subaru Legacy on I-93 in Concord, NH. During the traffic stop, a male occupant brandished a firearm and pointed it at the Officers. The vehicle then fled the traffic stop. A BOLO (Be On The Lookout) for the vehicle was distributed to surrounding agencies.

On August 28, 2025 the vehicle was located by a New Hampshire State Trooper at the Circle K gas station at 500 Rt. 3A in Bow, NH. The suspect was contacted and arrested at that location. While being taken into custody, the suspect attempted to grab the Trooper's rifle and was eventually placed into handcuffs. Arrested was:

UPDATE – Following Sanborn's initial arrest, Concord Police Detectives conducted an extensive investigation into the original encounter, which included conducting interviews, executing search warrants, and collecting evidence. On September 11, 2025, the Concord Police Department charged Bruce Sanborn with the following:

Sanborn has been held at the Merrimack County House of Corrections on preventative detention status since his original arrest. He was arraigned in Concord District Court on the above charges on September 12, 2025.
