CONCORD, NH – On October 3, 2025 at approximately 7:10 p.m., the Concord Police and Concord Fire Department responded to the area of 231 Loudon Road (Irving Gas Station) to investigate a traffic crash involving a motor vehicle and a bicyclist.

Upon arrival, Officers learned the involved vehicle left the area after the crash. The bicyclist was transported to Concord Hospital by the Concord Fire Department, where they later died. The identity of the subject will not be released at this time. Loudon Road was closed for several hours, but has since been reopened to traffic.

The Concord Police Department is actively investigating this crash. The Concord Police Department is requesting to speak with anyone who witnessed this crash, specifically anyone driving in the area of the Irving Gas Station between about 7:00 p.m. and 7:10 p.m.
