UNATTENDED DEATH

CONCORD, NH – On November 14, 2025 at approximately 1:15 P.M. the Concord Police Department responded to the Walmart Store on Loudon Rd. in Concord, NH to investigate the report of an Unattended Death call for service. It was initially reported that a male was seated inside a parked vehicle with an apparent gun shot wound. The subject was confirmed to be deceased at the scene.

While the investigation continued, it was discovered that a second vehicle parked nearby contained a male subject seated inside who was also confirmed deceased.

The identity of the deceased subjects will not be released at this time as these incidents remain active and ongoing investigations. The manner of death of the deceased subjects has yet to be determined. At this time, there is believed to be no threat to the general public related to these incidents.
