### CRIMINAL THREATENING

CONCORD, NH – On November 18, 2025 at approximately 7:35 p.m. the Concord Police Department responded to an address on Elm Street in Concord, NH to investigate a disturbance. It was reported that an argument occurred and that a firearm was discharged into the floor of a residence. No injuries were sustained by any of the subjects involved in the incident. After responding to the incident, it was learned that the suspect left the scene prior to officer's arrival. The suspect was later located in Loudon, NH and taken into custody by the Concord Police Department. The suspect was identified as:

**DYLAN LESSARD, AGE 23**  
**LOUDON, NH**

Dylan was arrested on the following charges:

**CRIMINAL THREATENING (3 COUNTS) (FELONY)**  
**DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CRIMINAL THREATENING (3 COUNTS) (FELONY)**  
**RECKLESS CONDUCT (FELONY)**  
**FALSIFYING PHYSICAL EVIDENCE (FELONY)**  
**CRIMINAL MISCHIEF (MISDEMEANOR)**  
**DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED (MISDEMEANOR)**

This was determined to be an isolated incident and it is believed that there is no current threat to the public related to this incident at this time. Lessard was held on no bail status and transported to the Merrimack County House of Corrections. Lessard was scheduled to appear at Concord District Court on November 19, 2025 for arraignment.
