BOMB THREAT & SUSPICIOUS ITEM REPORT

CPD Incident # 25-44697-OF

CONCORD, NH - On November 21, 2025 at approximately 3:54 p.m., the Concord Police Department received information of a potential threat towards 18 North Main Street.

Upon learning this information, Officers closed North Main Street between Pleasant Street and School Street. New Hampshire State Police Bomb Squad responded and assisted in a search of the area and building. At the conclusion of the search, the threat was dispelled and the road was opened. There is no threat to the public at this time.

CONCORD, NH – On November 21, 2025 at approximately 3:51 p.m., just minutes prior to receiving the information about the threat at 18 North Main Street, a report of several hazardous items wired together were observed in the wooded area of 15 Integra Drive. Officers responded to the area and confirmed the presence of hazardous items. New Hampshire State Police Bomb Squad responded and dispelled the concern and ensured all items were rendered safe.

These cases remain active and are ongoing investigations.
