CONCORD, NH – On February 27, 2026 at approximately 6:51 p.m., the Concord Police Department responded to St. Paul’s School for the report of an unwanted guest. It was reported that a male was in the dining hall causing a disturbance and acting belligerently. It was reported that the male had no association with the school.

Concord Police Officers arrived on scene and made contact the male who was identified as:

**ELIJAH ALLMAN, AGE 49**  
**MALIBU, CA**

As a result of the incident, ALLMAN was charged with:

**(x2) Simple Assault – Misdemeanor A**  
**Criminal Trespass – Misdemeanor A**  
**Criminal Threatening – Misdemeanor A**  
**Disorderly Conduct – Violation**

ALLMAN was processed and released on personal recognizance bail. ALLMAN is to appear on April 20, 2026 at 8:15 a.m. at the Concord District Court for arraignment on the above described matter.
