

Weather Policy

Game Days

In case of bad weather on the day of a game for Div. 2 & 3 the officials scheduled for the game will make a decision to cancel if they feel conditions are dangerous. In case of bad weather for Division I and Fundamentals, on Saturdays the decision will be made by Concord Parks and Recreation staff, coaches will receive an email and it will also be posted on our Facebook page.

Practices

In the case of bad weather during practices, Coaches should use their best judgment to cancel or postpone practice. Please be sure to notify all players should this occur.

Should thunder occur after a game or practice has begun, please keep in mind thunder occurs as a result of lightning. If thunder can be heard, then the presence of lightning is real, even though it may not be immediately observed. Because lightning is attracted to the tallest object in the area, patrons and employees should not be allowed to congregate under trees, umbrellas, or other tall objects. Games/practices need to be postponed until the thunderstorm passes – at least 30 minutes after last hearing the thunder or sighting of lightning.
