AN ORDINANCE

Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, so as to add a Public Safety Advisory Board.

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

Section I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title V, Administrative Code, Chapter 30, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, by adding the following new Section 30-3-25, Public Safety Advisory Board.

30-3-25 Public Safety Board.

- (a) The Public Safety Board shall consist of nineteen (19) members:
- (1) Three (3) members of the City Council appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council; one of whom shall be named as Chair by the Mayor;
 - (2) Eleven (11) members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council: three (3) members shall be a student in the City; one (1) member shall be a "senior citizen" at least 65 years of age; one (1) member shall be active in youth services; one (1) member shall be active in Domestic Violence Prevention and Intervention; one (1) member shall be active in Substance Abuse Education and Treatment; one (1) member representing the Concord Area Compact; one (1) retired Concord fire fighter; one (1) retired Concord police officer; one (1) member at large;
 - (3) One (1) member representing the Concord School District;
 - (4) One (1) member representing the Merrimack Valley School District;
 - (5) The Police Chief, Fire Chief, and City Manager, or their designee, shall be ex-officio members of the Public Safety Advisory Council;
 - (6) The members shall be residents of the City of Concord. All members shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years. Vacancies shall be appointed to fill the unexpired terms as necessary.

AN ORDINANCE

Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, so as to add a Public Safety Advisory Board (page 2).

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

- (b) Members shall elect a Clerk who shall submit quarterly activity reports to the City Council. The members of the Board shall meet quarterly, and at such times as may be deemed necessary by the Chair or the other ex-officio members.
- (c) The members of the Advisory Board shall make an annual report to the City Council on the state of public safety in the City of Concord at the regular March City Council meeting. The report shall include recommendations for action by the City Council to improve the state of public safety within the City of Concord.
- (d) The members of the Advisory Board shall:
 - (1) Encourage citizen participation in the enhancement of public safety in the City of Concord;
 - (2) Assist with the review of neighborhood needs in public safety, considering the various state and federal grant programs available for financing these needs, and recommend projects to the City Council for funding; and
 - (3) Consider special projects as referred by the City Council.

Section II: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
