

Youth Scholarship Procedure

Annually the department awards youth scholarships to over 400 resident (Concord/Penacook) youth to help them take part in our camps and programs. Our ability to award youth scholarships is due in part to private donations from local businesses and people who are able to “pay in forward”. Many people donate to the scholarship fund when registering for a program or camp; while others just send a check and include Youth Scholarship Fund in the memo section. All donations large or small help make a difference!

Traditional All-Day Summer Camp Scholarship Process:

We offer partial scholarships for our traditional “all day” summer camps: Stay and Play and Adventure Camps. Anyone requesting a scholarship is required to pre-register and pay a non-refundable \$20.00 deposit to hold a spot and fill out scholarship form. Once the scholarship request is reviewed a Concord Parks & Recreation staff member will be in touch with the final amount due. Please note these camps have limited space and do fill up.

Specialty Camp Scholarship Process:

We are able to offer a limited amount of scholarships for our specialty camps (soccer and basketball) based on the agreements with the camp providers. Anyone requesting a scholarship is required to pre-register and pay a non-refundable \$20.00 deposit to hold a spot and fill out scholarship form. Once the scholarship request is reviewed a Concord Parks & Recreation staff member will be in touch with the final amount due. Please note these camps have limited space and do fill up.
