

THE CONCORD BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S CLUB was formed and started in the Spring of 1928. A group of women gathered together and set up the By-Laws and adopted a Constitution for the Club. The first meeting was held in October, 1928 at The Friendly House Gym at 20 South Main Street. Two meetings a month were held on the first and third Thursday of each month. One meeting to be devoted for Educational Purpose and the other meeting for Social and Entertainment enjoyment, which we do up to this day.

A Bowling Club was organized two years later in 1930 which is still very active. In the early years of the Club, Summer Outings and Bridge and Whist Card Parties were held. These we do not carry on, as times have changed this plan.

Our Club is very active to date and we have a membership close to 125. Our meetings are now held in the Chamberlain House at #46 Pleasant Street. This is a beautiful home owned by The Concord Woman's Club and used by various Women's groups. This Fall our Bowling Club will be celebrating their 35th. Anniversary with 75 members strong, which is a wonderful record.

Our Club supports many worthwhile projects in Concord. We made a generous donation to the new Concord Hospital and now are making one to the Concord Y.M.C.A new building which is being erected. We belong to the Concord Chamber of Commerce and Concord Safety Council.

We have eight Charter Members still active and twelve Past-Presidents with us. Our Club Motto is "Not What the Club Can Do For Us

but
